CHARTER OF RIGHTS BREACHES:

Section 7: Life, liberty and security of person - VIOLATED

Section 8: Unreasonable search and seizure - VIOLATED

Section 9: Arbitrary detention - VIOLATED

Section 10(b): Right to counsel - VIOLATED

Section 11(d): Fair trial rights - VIOLATED

Section 24: Enforcement of rights - VIOLATED

RECORDED EVIDENCE: "I demand my constitutional rights" - DENIED

CRIMINAL CODE VIOLATIONS

OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE (Section 139):

Crown Attorney tampering with evidence

Suppressing exculpatory evidence

Coordinating false prosecutions

PENALTY: Up to 10 years imprisonment

BREACH OF TRUST (Section 122):

Public officials violating duties

Using office for corrupt purposes

Betraying public trust

PENALTY: Up to 5 years imprisonment

CONSPIRACY (Section 465):

Multiple parties coordinating corruption

Systematic coordination over 4 years

Evidence tampering conspiracy

PENALTY: Up to 14 years imprisonment

Converting Civil to Criminal: Fraudulent charges

Coercion: Forcing payments for non-existent damage

Deliberate Misconduct: "I know what I'm doing"

Evidence Suppression: Withholding exculpatory evidence
