PART IV — STANDING CLAUSE RE: RECOVERY

All monetary relief sought against any Respondent named in this Schedule — whether in the form of general damages, special damages, aggravated damages, exemplary damages, punitive damages, costs, restitution, disgorgement of profits, RICO treble damages under 18 U.S.C. § 1964(c), civil-penalty recovery, or any other pecuniary remedy — is by operation of this pleading assigned **in full (100%)** to the **Canadian People’s Trust v2**, a public-benefit trust, for the purposes enumerated in the Trust Deed and summarized at <https://canadianpeoplestrust.pages.dev/trust.html>, namely:
