## STATUTE-BY-STATUTE — THE CRIMES COMMITTED BY SILENCE

### CANADIAN CRIMINAL CODE

#### **s.122 Criminal Code** — Breach of trust by public officer.

Every named public officer who received a demand and refused to act is in breach of trust.

Maximum penalty: 5 years imprisonment.

#### **s.139 Criminal Code** — Obstruction of justice.

Every named justice system participant who received a mandamus and refused to perform duty is obstructing.

Maximum penalty: 10 years imprisonment.

#### **s.264 Criminal Code** — Criminal harassment.

WPS, RCMP, Crown — 21 years of coordinated refusal has crossed the threshold into criminal

harassment of the applicant.  
Maximum penalty: 10 years imprisonment.

**s.380(1)(a) Criminal Code** — Fraud over \$5,000.  
Sun Life Financial — \$707,000 paid on a forged will. The forged will has been probated. The payment is recoverable. The beneficiaries of a forged will hold no good title.  
Maximum penalty: 14 years imprisonment.

## JUDICIAL COUNCIL ACTS

**Judicial Council Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. J-1, s.5(2)** — Grounds for removal of a federally-appointed judge.  
CJC File 26-0430 has been open 89+ days without substantive action.  
The Chairperson, the Right Honourable Richard Wagner P.C., has been personally served (June 4, 2026 — Annex A).

**Provincial Judges Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.32, s.51(3)** — Grounds for removal of a provincially-appointed judge.  
Justice Maria Carroccia — Habeas Corpus #1 and #2, 127+ and 110+ days in default.  
The Ontario Judicial Council is on notice.

## CHARTER S.7

**Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, s.7** — Right to life, liberty, and security of the person; not to be deprived thereof except in accordance with the principles of fundamental justice.  
The 127+ day delay on Habeas Corpus #1 (SCJ Windsor) is itself a s.7 breach by the duty-warden.

## INTERNATIONAL TREATIES

**United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime (Palermo, 2000), Art. 7, 9, 23** — State obligations to criminalize, prosecute, and cooperate.  
Republic of Italy — in default since the 2007 fabricated consular record.  
Canada — in default since the 2005 Tampa FBI warrant and the 2016 Raffi Ceylan murder cover-up.

**Vienna Convention on Consular Relations (1969), Art. 36** — Consular access for detained nationals.

The 2007 consular record held by the Republic of Italy was fabricated. The fabrication has been documented. Italy has refused for 19 years to acknowledge, investigate, or correct.

**Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court, Art. 19** — Referral obligation when national proceedings are compromised.

Italy and Canada have concurrent obligations. Both are in default.

**Codice Penale, art. 328** — Rifiuto di atti d'ufficio · Refusal to perform an act of office.  
Maximum penalty: 1 year imprisonment or fine.

**Codice Penale, art. 361, 362** — Omissione di atti d'ufficio · Omission of duty by public officer.  
Maximum penalty: 1 year imprisonment.

4. Complaint to the Canadian Judicial Council against the Right Honourable Richard Wagner P.C. for failure to act on CJC File 26-0430 within statutory timeframe.
